Starting from 1st April, 2023 the deemed residual maturity of Basel III AT-1 bonds will be 100 years.

Mutual funds are one of the largest investors in perpetual debt investments and currently hold Rs 35,000 crores in AT-1.

ADB's largest-ever borrowing in an Asian local currency. It is the first borrowing of ADB from a CNY10 billion program approved by regulator National Association of Financial Market Institutional Investors in June 2020.
